These interim standalone financial informations have been reviewed by other auditors whose reports have been furnished to us by the Management and our report on the Statement, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of these subsidiaries including step down subsidiaries is based solely on the reports of the other auditors and the procedures performed by us as stated in paragraph 3 above.
