

AUDITOR'S REPORT

To the members of

We have audited the attached Balance Sheet of Romano Infrastructure Private Limited as at March 31, 2012, the related Statement of Profit and Loss and the Cash Flow Statement for the year ended on that date annexed thereto. These financial statements are the responsibility of the Company's management. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit.

We conducted our audit in accordance with the auditing standards generally accepted in India. Those standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free of material misstatements. 1 SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

a) BASIS OF PREPARATION OF FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

The financial statements of the Company have been prepared in accordance with the Indian Generally Accepted Accounting Principles ("Indian GAAP"). The Company has prepared these financial statements to comply in all material aspects with the accounting standard notified under the Companies (Accounting Standard) Rules, 2006 as amended and the relevant provision of the Companies Act, 1956. The financial statement have been prepared under the historical cost convention and on accrual basis.

The accounting policies adopted in the preparation and presentation of financial statements are consistent with those of previous year. The management evaluates all recently issued or revised accounting standards on a ongoing basis.

During the year ended March 31, 2012, the revised Schedule VI notified under the Companies Act, 1956, has become applicable to the Company, for preparation and presentation of its financial statement. The adoption of revised Schedule VI does not impact recognition and measurement principles followed for preparation of financial statements. However, it has significant impact on presentation and disclosures made in the financial statements. The Company has also reclassified previous year figures in accordance with the requirements applicable in the current year.

b) RECOGNITION OF REVENUE AND EXPENDITURE

Income and expenditure are accounted for on accrual basis.

c) EARNINGS PER SHARE

The Company reports basic and diluted earnings per share (EPS) in accordance with Accounting Standard 20 on Earnings Per Share. Basic EPS is computed by dividing the net profit or loss for the year attributable to equity shareholders by the weighted average number of equity shares outstanding during the year. Diluted EPS is computed by dividing the net profit or loss for the year attributable to equity shareholders by the weighted average number of equity shares outstanding during the year as adjusted for the effects of all dilutive potential equity shares, except where the results are anti-dilutive.

d) CASH FLOW STATEMENT

Cash flows are reported using indirect method, whereby net profit before tax is adjusted for the effects of transactions of a non-cash nature and any deferrals or accruals of past or future cash receipts or payments. The cash flows from regular revenue generating, investing and financing activities of the Company are segregated.
