1 SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

a) BASIS OF PREPARATION OF FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

The financial statements of the Company have been prepared in accordance with the Indian Generally Accepted Accounting Principles ("Indian GAAP"). The cash flows from regular revenue generating, investing and financing activities of the Company are segregated.

e) EARNINGS PER SHARE

The Company reports basic and diluted earnings per share (EPS) in accordance with Accounting Standard 20 on Earnings Per Share. Basic EPS is computed by dividing the net profit or loss for the year attributable to equity shareholders by the weighted average number of equity shares outstanding during the year. Diluted EPS is computed by dividing the net profit or loss for the year attributable to equity shareholders by the weighted average number of equity shares outstanding during the year as adjusted for the effects of all dilutive potential equity shares, except where the results are anti-dilutive.

f) CASH AND CASH EQUIVALENTS

In the Cash Flow Statement, cash and cash equivalents includes cash in hand, demand deposits with banks, other short term highly liquid investments with original maturity of three months or less.
