Odisha partially rolls back decision to cancel discretionary quota houses

THE ODISHA Government has backtracked from its decision taken eight years ago to cancel nearly 1,800 flats/ houses/ residential plots in Bhubaneswar and Cuttack, which were allotted under the discretionary quota (DQ) by various state-owned agencies.


At a meeting of the state cabinet on Friday, it was decided that allotments made under DQ, which have been made in terms of the brochure and schemes to persons who are single allottees by state-owned agencies, "which can be considered as genuine and which is in sync with court orders" will be excluded from the purview of a task force report, based on which the decision to cancel the allotments was taken in 2014.

The three-member task force, headed by then revenue secretary Taradatt, had submitted a 592-page report on November 3, 2014.

A month later, on December 18, the state cabinet had decided to cancel all allotments made under DQ since January 1, 1995. A vigilance inquiry was also ordered into those cases of multiple allotments to individuals/families on the basis of false affidavits or misleading information.

A total of 1,791 discretionary allotments were made (between 1995 and 2011) to influential people – 803 by Bhubaneswar Development Authority (BDA), 921 by Cuttack Development Authority (CDA) and 67 by Odisha State Housing Board (OSHB). Among them, 54 people were allotted multiple properties.

SC grants pre-arrest bail to woman booked for sexually assaulting minor stepdaughter

THE SUPREME Court recently granted pre-arrest bail to a step-mother, booked in November 2021 for allegedly sexually assaulting and harassing her minor stepdaughter, for nearly seven years.

The stepmother, who approached the SC after the Bombay High Court rejected her plea, had alleged that the case against her is an "calculated attempt of the appellant's husband, to throw her out of her matrimonial residence, of which she is a part owner by virtue of a registered gift deed".

The FIR lodged against the woman alleged that since 2017, she had been causing mental harassment to her stepdaughter – would hurl obscene abuses –

Khalid Jawed's novel wins JCB Prize for Literature

'THE PARADISE of Food' by Khalid Jawed, translated from Urdu by Baran Farooqi, won JCB Prize for Literature on Saturday.

The book, originally published as 'Nemat Khana' in 2014, is the fourth translation to win the award and the first work in Urdu.

'The Paradise of Food' tells the story of a middle-class joint Muslim family over a span of fifty years where the narrator struggles to find a place for himself, at odds in his home and the world outside.

Jawed received the prize money of Rs 25 lakh along with a trophy. Farooqi received an additional Rs 10 lakh for the award.

Speaking after receiving the award at a function held in New Delhi, Jawed said, "I'm experi-

encing a real moment of joy today. I didn't expect this at all. I wrote this novel in 2014 in Urdu, and today its star has shone. Because of Farooqi, it has been transported into another language and world. Now it has received international recognition."

Farooqi said, "Salman Rushdie used a Ghalib quote in one of his own books translated by my father, Mehr Afshan Farooqi. It goes: 'If there is a knower of tongues here, fetch him/There's a stranger in the city/ and he has many things to say.' Urdu is not spoken as much in our country today, and someone needed to speak for it."

The jury consisted of journalist and editor AS Panneerselvam, (chair); author Amitabha Bagchi, author and academician Rakhee Balaram, translator, historian and academician J Devika and author Janice Pariat.

Talking about the winning work, Panneerselvam said it is "a celebration of human spirit, hope, loss, aspirations, and anxiety".

All the five novels short-listed for this year's award were translated works.

Other works in the shortlist announced on October 21 were Tomb of Sand by Geetanjali Shree, translated from Hindi by Daisy Rockwell; Song of the Soil by Chuden Kabimo, translated from Nepali by Ajit Baral ; Imaan by Manoranjan Byapari, translated from Bengali by Arunava Sinha and Valli by Sheela Tomy, translated from Malayalam.

It was for the first time that titles in Hindi and Nepali made it to the shortlist of the literary award.

Gauhati HC Chief Justice slams bulldozer action: 'Gang war or police op?'

COMING DOWN heavily on an Assam Superintendent of Police for bulldozing the house of an arson accused, the Gauhati High Court has said police cannot, "under the guise of investigation", bulldoze anyone's house without permission, and if such practices continue then "nobody is safe in this country".

Hearing a suo motu case on the demolition of the house of a person accused in an arson case in Nagaon district, Chief Justice R M Chhaya, heading a division bench also comprising Justice Soumitra Saikia, said, "Show me from any criminal jurisprudence that for investigating the crime, the police, without any order, can uproot a person, apply a bulldozer. As per the report... police needed an excavator to dig the house. For that, he requires permission."

When the SP's counsel tried to argue that police had permission from the District Magistrate to search the house,

Chief Justice Chhaya said the permission was for searching, not bulldozing.

He said any police officer, however senior the person may be, has to work under the ambit of law and if arbitrary actions are allowed, nobody will be safe in the country anymore.

"He may be SP of any district, even your IG, DIG, whoever may be, the IAS authority, the DG, he has to pass through the gamut of law. Only because they head the police department, they can't break anybody's house. Nobody is safe in this country then, if this is permitted. We are not that. Procedure has to be followed," he said.

Indians live in a democratic set-up and no official of the police or administration can bulldoze someone's house without requisite permission under the guise of investigation, he said.

"In my limited career here and at the Bar, I have not come across any police officer using a bulldozer by way of a search warrant."

"In a lighter vein, I have not seen even Hindi movies of that

category. Director Shetty can present a story of your SP. Rohit Shetty? He can make a film of this. Is it a gang war or a police operation?... I forgot the name of the movie... I Ajay Devgn's. For that also, he had to show the order," the Chief Justice said.

Asking the SP's counsel to take up the bulldozing matter with higher-ups in the police administration, he said, "Your DG may not be knowing also, about this incident. Put it to the notice of higher-ups... put it to some higher-up in the Home department or this will never be resolved. You have to find out, carve out a way out of it. You can prosecute him (accused) for whatever offence he has committed... Who gave power to your SP to bulldoze the house?"

Stating that the words law and order are used together in Indian jurisprudence, the Chief Justice said law and order cannot be controlled by bulldozing someone's house under the "guise of investigation".

The High Court set December 12 as the next date of hearing.

Punjab notifies old pension scheme, mum on implementation

THE PUNJAB government Saturday notified the old pension scheme only mentioning briefly

that the employees covered under national pension scheme would be given benefits of the old scheme. This comes a day after the state Cabinet approved its implementation and nearly two months after Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann announced that Punjab would be reverting to the old pension scheme.


The notification issued by the finance department, however, did not shed light on when the government would stop taking contribution from the employees. The notification said that the detailed scheme and standard operating procedures (SOPs) would be notified later.

"In exercise of the powers

conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution, and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor is pleased to notify that all government employees presently being covered under the Defined Contributory Pension Scheme also referred to as National Pension System (PS) will be given the benefits of Old Pension Scheme (OPS)," read the notification. It further said, "Detailed scheme and Standard Operating Procedures pursuant to this notification shall be notified in due course of time."

The state is supposed to request the Pension Fund Regulatory and Development Authority to refund Rs 16,746 crore, the corpus accumulated under the NPS. The Cabinet on Friday had given nod to notify the OPS, stating the move would benefit 1.75 lakh employees currently covered under NPS.
