Yediyurappa wins trust, Speaker quits

Bengaluru, 29 July

The three-day-old BJP government in Karnataka, headed by B.S. Yediyurappa, on Monday got its majority in the truncated Assembly, winning the confidence motion by a voice vote in a smooth affair.

Speaker K. R. Ramesh Kumar announced his resignation soon after Yediyurappa won the trust vote, a process lasting less than an hour after the House met.

With the BJP comfortably placed in the minority again after disqualification of 17 MLAs who had reduced the effective strength of the House, the Opposition Congress and JD(S) did not press for a division.

The Speaker declared that the one-line motion expressing confidence in the Ministry headed by Kumaraswamy had been adopted by the House.

On the eve of the trust vote, Kumar had dismissed all Congress MLAs from the House except at the end of the current term of the House in 2023, in addition to three earlier, bringing down the majority mark to 105, equivalent of the current strength of the BJP which had the support of an independent.



The Congress has 66 members, JDS 34, the Speaker one (who has a casting vote in case of a tie) and one expelled BSP member who was thrown out of the party for violating norms of the party. The H.D. Kumaraswamy government during the trust vote on July 24.

As was also expected, the Speaker announced his resignation after a 14-month tenure in office amid reports that the BJP was

mulling moving a no-confidence motion against him.

"I have decided to resign," Kumar said, handed over his letter of resignation to Deputy Speaker Krishnam Reddy.

Kumar said as the Speaker, he had won't according to his conscience and in accordance to the Constitution.

"I have upheld the dignity of

office to the best of my ability," he added.

Moving the confidence motion, Yediyurappa said he would not indulge in "politics of vengeance" and "forgive and forget" for his principle."

He said the administrative machinery had collapsed and his priority was to bring it back on track. "My becoming the chief minister is according to expectations of

'Criteria for identifying risky exporters not made clear by CBIC'

My query is regarding circular No. 16/2019-Customs dated June 17, 2019. I understand large numbers of exporters have been put on alert by RMCC subject to 100 per cent mandatory examination of export consignment relating to risky exporters. What are the criteria to identify risky exporters? Please advise remedial measures for exporters.

That circular only says, "DG (Systems) shall work out the suitable criteria to identify risky exporters at the national level and forward the list of said risky exporters to Risk Management Centre for Customs (RMCC) and respective Chief Commissioners of Central Tax. DG (Systems) shall inform the respective Chief Commissioners of Central Tax about the past IGST refunds granted to such risky exporters along with details of bank accounts in which such refund has been disbursed." A subsequent Circular No. 22/2019-Customs dated July 24, 2019, says that only a minuscule percentage of export consignments will be selected for examination on account of risk associated with fraudulent availing of IGST refunds. However, keeping in view the above, it is advised that the concerned Board has decided that the requirement of 100 per cent physical examination of each export consignment shall be gradually relaxed provided no irregularity was noticed in earlier examinations of export consignments of export entitlements in terms of Circular No. 16/2019-Customs dated June 17, 2019. It also

says that that RMCC shall take into consideration the feedback received from field formations with regard to the 100 per cent examination conducted on exports of risk-based identified entities and wherever the examination has validated the declaration made in the circular, RMCC may relax the risk assessment and gradually taper down the percentage of physical examination. Suitable slants based on re-evaluated risk may accordingly be inserted in the system by RMCC in such cases, the circular says.

We had exported certain goods where initially we had inadvertently paid lower IGST under refund claim. Subsequently, after two months, we paid the differential amount of tax. Are we required to pay interest on the same?

In my opinion, you must pay the interest.

Can you let me know the purpose of e-commerce through courier and post?

In case of exports through courier, you have to follow the procedure prescribed in the Courier Imports and Exports Clearance Regulation, 2018. For exports by post, you have to follow the procedure prescribed in the Export by Post Regulations, 2018. The forms to be filled in by you for exports through e-commerce are also given in the said Regulations.

As an EPCG authorisation holder, we did job-work for an exporter by way of embroidery on garments and involved the exporter for the job-work done. Can invoice value in rupees representing job-work go towards calculation of export obligation (EO)? Is it in order to convert the rupee value of invoice into US\$ at the exchange rate prevalent on the date of issuance of authorisation?

There is no provision in the EPCG scheme to count such rupee earnings on domestic job-work towards discharge of EO.

Unnao rape survivor car crash: UP govt in a dock

In an FIR, registered on Monday for murder and attempt to murder, The FIR, in which 15 unarmed people were also mentioned, was registered at the Gurdaspur police station in Rakhbari.

The Opposition raised the issue in both Houses of Parliament. The Ray Sabha was adjourned for 15 minutes. Congress' Manish Tewari demanded the Supreme Court take up the case suo motu and an independent investigation. A protest was held at India Gate. Several state legislators from Unnao, about seven of whom were from the Congress, attended the protest. Some of them were injured.

While her parents were killed, the rape survivor, her sister and their lawyer sustained grievous injuries when their car hit head-on by a truck. The injured were shifted to King George's Medical University, Lucknow, where their condition is stated to be critical. Sengar was among the 10 people named

arrested. They are being questioned, even as the state government said it will be transferred to CBI if demanded by the rape survivor's family. Police said the registration plate of the truck that hit the car carrying the rape survivor's family was scrubbed, but they managed to retrieve the number.

The mother of the rape survivor, who suffered serious injuries in the accident, told the media that Sunday's incident was a conspiracy to wipe out her family. Yadav attacked the Adityanath government and slammed the police for intimidating the survivor's family. Congress Secretary Priyanka Gandhi termed the incident shocking. "Why is there lady in the security of the victim and the witnesses? You can hope for any justice from the BJP government without an answer to these questions," she tweeted.
